



Advent Dove.



1. Stuff the Dove.



2. Fold the opening flat, between your thumb and finger.



3, 4 and 5. Work a short row of approx. 8 dc and finish off. This should leave you with 8 unworked stitches around the tail.



6 and 7. Rejoin the yarn at the start of the 8 unworked tail stitches and working in to the back loops only work the following stitch pattern: 1 sl st, 3dc in the next st, 3htr in the next st, 2tr in each of the next 2 sts, 3htr in the next st, 3dc in the next and finish with 1 sl st. Finish off.



Turn the dove over and sew in the two ends, closing any remaining hole.



Round 28: work 3 more dc at the end of the round (16 sts)

Round 29: *1d, dc2tog* Repeat from *to* end of round, finish with 1 more dc.
Use raspberry for the final yarn over (11sts)
